

WoodenBoat Maritime Tour to the Netherlands, June 16 – 26, 2013

Terms & Conditions

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

U.S. Citizens must be in possession of a valid passport with not less than six months validity remaining. Non U.S. Citizens should consult the appropriate consulates.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENT

A deposit of \$1000 per person for the 2013 *WoodenBoat Maritime Tour to the Netherlands* should be submitted with the completed and signed reservation form to Borton Overseas to confirm your booking. The trip balance is due no later than April 16, 2013.

RATES AND FARES

Prices are based on guaranteed, advanced bookings at Borton Overseas' contract rate with each supplier (i.e. hotels); seasonal and occupancy variations may occur. Borton Overseas are not responsible for any such price variances. In each case the quoted cost represents a complete package price and an itemization of individual component cost will not be rendered. Clients will be responsible for any charges required due to voluntary itinerary deviations at the request of the traveler.

Flights from the participants' home city in connection with the tour will be booked upon receipt of tour deposit and the best available airfare will be using Delta Airlines.

Tour Cancellation Policy: Cancellations must be submitted to Borton Overseas in writing. For cancellations received after deposit – February 1, 2013, a \$600 per person penalty will apply. Between February 2 and April 16, the deposit is not refundable. Between April 17 and May 17, a 75% penalty of the total tour cost will apply. For cancellations received after May 17, 2013, there is no refund. No refund can be made for any tour accommodation, service or feature that passengers do not utilize or voluntarily change; if participant cancels while tour is in progress, there will be no refund for unused portions.

Changes to the airline ticket after departure will result in a ticket reissuance fee and any difference in the airfare.

BAGGAGE

Please note: In economy class, *Delta* allows 1 piece of checked luggage per person maximum 50 lbs/piece, 62 linear inches (length + width + height). As a carry-on, *Delta* allows 1 piece of luggage, 45 linear inches, in addition to a purse, laptop, camera bag or other small bag.

TOUR PRICE INCLUDES

Airfare, air taxes and carrier-imposed international surcharge, all arrangements of ship charter, hotel accommodations with private bath or shower, hotel taxes, service charges, sightseeing, entrances and transportation as described in the itinerary and meals as listed (B=Breakfast, L=Lunch, L = lunch, D=Dinner), emergency accident, medical, baggage, trip delay, 24 hour AD & D travel insurance. Insurance details will be provided with your tour confirmation.

NOT INCLUDED

Passport fees, all items of personal nature including laundry, room service, beverages, meals not specified in the itinerary or items not included in the tour, luggage handling, trip cancellation insurance, tips for drivers and guides. Travelers will be responsible for any charges required due to voluntary itinerary deviations at their request.

Trip cancellation insurance can be added for a supplement. Please ask for details. Travel Insurance once paid is a non-refundable premium

Documents will be sent out approximately 3 weeks prior to departure from the US. Final documents will not be sent out until final payment and the signed reservation form has been received. If documents are lost, replacement documents are subject to a \$50 re-issuance fee.
